What is the Pentateuch?

- The Torah (Hebrew The Law, Deut.
 31:9)
- The Pentateuch (Greek Five scrolls)
- The Books of Moses
- The first five books in the Bible



What makes up the Pentateuch

- Genesis: World History and Israel
- Exodus: Leave Egypt, Receive Law, Apostasy, Grace
- Leviticus: Cultic matters Sacrifice, Atone, Purity
- Numbers: Wanderings, Census
- Deuteronomy: Decalogue (2nd), Covenant (If...)



Themes in the Pentateuch

• Genesis 1 and 2

- Many gods at the time (13th 16th century BC)
- Moses says that Elohim is the true God!
- Elohim "God of gods" or "The Power over the powers."

Suzerain-Vassal Relationships

- "If I do this, you will do that."
- I give you land and protection
- You promise me your loyalty



• Preamble to the Decalogue

- "I am the LORD your God who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery."
- Benevolent King; what He has **already** done

• What is the King asking for in response?

- "No other gods before me"
- "Thou shalt not..."
- Vassal is to pledge loyalty and peace in Kingdom



Creation

- I made you and I made a garden
- You work and **guard** the garden (Ge. 2:15)



- The "alien", the "stranger", or the "other"
 - Mentioned over 50 times
 - Always in respect of 'how to treat' them
 - Because you too; Ephesians 2:11-12
 - Who is the "other" in your life?



• The Pentateuch ends (Dt 34):

- Moses, Israel's leader, is dead
- Israel looks across the Jordan at Promised Land
- A new guy, Joshua, takes over
- How would you feel?



Genesis

• Chapter 1 and Chapter 2

- Two Creation stories side-by-side
- One author or two?
 - Elohim vs Yahweh Elohim Why?
 - Details of Day 6?
- God's grace animal skins for covering (3:21)
- God's Compassion no more massive floods (9:11)



God Calling! Genesis/Exodus + Isaiah

Calling Method One

- Ge 12:1 "LORD said to Abram..." (Abraham)
- Ex 3:10 "Come, I will send you..." (Moses)
- Specific calls to specific people

Calling Method Two

- Isaiah 6:8 "Whom shall I send and who will go for us?"
- Isaiah was not specifically chosen
- Isaiah answered a general call



God Calling! Genesis/Exodus + Isaiah

Do you hear Yahweh calling?



Exodus

- Miracles (Chaps. 1-15)
 - Plagues
 - Crossing Red Sea
 - Protection (from Egypt)



Exodus

• Apostasy, Law, Grace (Chaps. 15-34)

- Complaining/Ungratefulness (mana, quail, water)
- Law given (Chaps. 20-31)
- Apostasy and Grace (Chaps. 31-34)
- Tabernacle and Priests (Chaps. 35-40)



Leviticus and Numbers

Leviticus

- Cultic Practices/Priesthood
- No forgiveness of sins without blood

• Numbers

- History
- Preparation for entry



Leviticus and Numbers

• IF you obey - God smiles!

- Leviticus 26:9, 12
- Numbers 6:24-26

• IF you do not obey - God frowns!

• Leviticus 26:17



Deuteronomy

• Retelling the story

- Decalogue given again (why?) 5:6-21
- Shema or "Listen!" 6:4-5
- Chosen People 7:6-11
 - Grace!



Deuteronomy

- Retelling the story
 - A new prophet is promised 18:15, 34:10
 - Across the Jordan from the Promised Land 34:1-9



Decalogue - Lutheran

- 5:7 No other gods
- 5:11 My name not in vain
- 5:12 Keep My Sabbath
- 5:16 Honor Ma and Pa

- 5:17 No murder
- 5:18 No adultery
- 5:19 No stealing
- 5:20 No false stories
- 5:21 No coveting neighbor's home
- 5:21 No coveting other stuff



. Decalogue -Protestant/Anglican

- 5:7 No other gods
- 5:8 No images of Me
- 5:11 My name not in vain
- 5:12 Keep My Sabbath

- 5:16 Honor Ma and Pa
- 5:17 No murder
- 5:18 No adultery
- 5:19 No stealing
- 5:20 No false stories
- 5:21 No coveting
